Abundance on Deseret Ranch:

- C = Common; likely to be found in appropriate habitat in the appropriate season.
- U = Uncommon; may be found in appropriate habitat in the appropriate season.
- R = Rare; usually reported annually, but seldom found, even in appropriate habitat and season.
- O = Occasional; not reported annually, but several records exist for the ranch.
- A = Accidental; only one or two records exist for the ranch.
- I = Irregular; abundance varies greatly from year to year.

Seasonal Occurrence Codes:

- S = Summer; present during the Summer months, usually June-August; may be present during the Spring and Fall migration; * denotes a species that breeds on the ranch; (*) denotes a species which possibly breeds on the ranch.
- W = Winter, present during the Winter months, usually November-March, may be present during the Spring and Fall migration.
- M = Migrant; generally present only during the Spring (March-May) and/or Fall (August-November) migration.
- P = Permanent resident; can be found on the ranch year-round. * denotes a species that breeds on the ranch; (*) denotes a species which possibly breeds on the ranch.
