

Deseret Land & Livestock Ranch Rules:

Sunday hunting is not permitted, and we ask that hunters not drink alcohol while on the CWMU.

In order to avoid conflict with other hunters and other ranch activities, hunters are not permitted to scout the CWMU prior to their hunt.

Hunters and guests must always check in and out with ranch personnel, through the main ranch headquarters near Woodruff, when entering or leaving the ranch.

Hunters must present harvested animals for inspection by ranch personnel prior to leaving the ranch, for collection of harvest data.

Hunters are allowed to shoot one and only one animal per permit. No hunting of additional animals is permitted once an animal has been wounded. A reasonable effort is expected on the part of the hunter to recover a wounded animal.

Hunters or guests are not to shoot, hunt or fish for any other wildlife species (including predators) while on the ranch.

All Utah and Federal laws and rules are to be obeyed. *For example*, Hunters must wear orange hats and vests if there is a rifle hunt occurring in the hunt area.

The use of horses, snowmobiles and ATV's are not permitted.

Hunters and guests may only drive vehicles on maintained roads.

Hunters and guests are expected to obey these ranch rules of conduct and any additional rules (such as seasonal road closures and fire restrictions) in effect while you are on the ranch.

Hunters and guests are expected to be courteous, ethical and sportsmanlike in their dealings with ranch personnel, other hunters and wildlife resources. Future hunting opportunities for you and others depends upon your conduct.
